The former Parish Council chambers and jail, the “Jougs”, has a fine example of a stepped Mercat Cross in an enclosure behind it . The pub here is to found adjacent to the said Jougs.

STEWARTON

At the time of publication none of the pubs in the “Bonnet Toun” serve real ale. However, a former outlet, the **Millhouse Hotel**, 6-8 Dean Street, KA3 5EQ is closed for refurbishment and the new owners claim they intend to offer real ale on re-opening.

DUNLOP

The sole pub (the Village Inn has sadly closed) in this historic village is within easy walking distance of the station.

This trail lists pubs that serve real ale close to stations between Kilmarnock and Dunlop on the line to Glasgow. Trains on this line run at half hourly intervals.

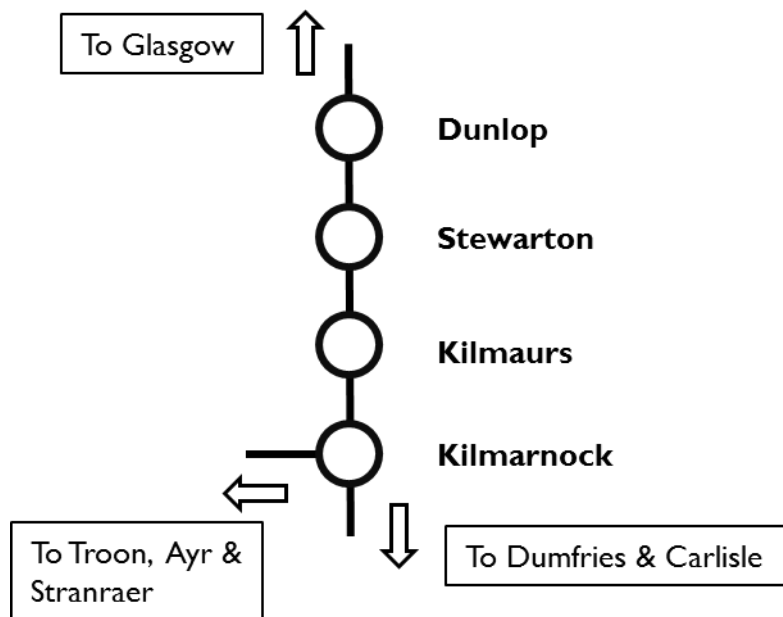
