Beer Scoring via WhatPub

All members are strongly encouraged to score their beer on each visit to a pub. The scores are used when selecting entries for the Good Beer Guide and monitoring beer quality.

To access the scoring system please follow these steps.

- Go to the website www.whatpub.com and login with your CAMRA membership number and password. If using your home computer, select Remember me and you will be logged on automatically in future.
- 2. Check the box to search for pubs and clubs that serve real ale.
- 3. Searching for the pub can be done by entering the name of the village or town in which the pub is located, or the pub name followed by the village or town name.
- 4. A list of pubs will be offered, and it may occupy more than one page. Choose the pub by clicking on the pub name with the correct town/village after it.
- 5. Under the heading **Submit Beer Scores**
 - a) Enter the date of your visit.
 - b) Enter your score by using the sliding scale or by choosing from the numerical list that appears.
 - c) In the **Brewery** window, start to enter the name of the brewery and a list will automatically appear. Please use this to select the correct name for the brewery.
 - d) Clicking in the **Beer** window generates a list of beers produced by that brewery. Please select the name of the beer. Should the beer not be listed, please leave blank.

Please note that (c) and (d) are now optional.

You now have a choice. Choose **Submit Score** or better still choose Show advanced options which will allow you to enter the price of the pint, including the decimal point and a brief comment on the beer quality.

If you have more scores for this pub select **Add another score** or if you have visited another pub, click on the **New search** button and go back to step 2

Log out when finished.
