Troon	14 Ayr - Irvine (SC)	Weekdays every 45 mins. 60/75mins at weekends.
	10/110 Troon - Kilmarnock (SC)	Hourly; three evening services; Every 90 minutes weekends.
Alloway, Maybole,	58/358 Ayr - Stranraer (SC) 60/360 Ayr - Girvan - Stranraer (SC)	Hourly 2-hourly weekends
	361 Straiton - Ayr - Dunure (SC)	Every two hours daytime. Not Sunday.
Kirkmichael	358 Ayr - Girvan (SC) 361 Straiton - Ayr - Dunure (SC)	Weekends evenings only 2-hourly. Not Sundays.
Kirkoswald	60/360 Ayr - Girvan - Stranraer (SC)	Hourly weekdays. 2-hourly weekends.

#### IRVINE / TROON / PRESTWICK

The 14 bus goes through these towns but they are also reachable by train - See **Trail 1 (Ayr to Irvine)** for full details of pubs in these areas.

#### **DUNDONALD**

Small village with a historic 14th century castle with buses from either Irvine or Troon to Kilmarnock and Crosshouse.





#### THE AUCHANS 29-31 Main Street, KA2 9HH 01563 851472

Up to two changing ales available

#### **MAYBOLE**

Small rural town in South Ayrshire which used to be the ancient capital of Carrick. There is also an hourly train service to Maybole from Ayr.





MAYBOLE ARMS 37 Whitehall, KA19 7DS 01655 883173

One changing ale often from local breweries.

#### **KIRKMICHAEL**

Small village 10 miles south of Ayr in the rolling rural Ayrshire countryside.





#### KIRKMICHAEL ARMS 3-5 Straiton Road, KA19 7PH 01655 750200

Two changing ales usually from Ayr Brewing Company

#### **KIRKOSWALD**

A small town on the main A77 steeped in the history of the poet Robert Burns. The pub is a thatched building that was originally the school that Robert Burns attended.





#### SOUTER'S INN 47 Main Road, KA19 8HY 01655 760653

Two ales usually available

#### **ALLOWAY**

The 58/358 and 60/360 buses also pass through the suburbs of Alloway close to Burns' Cottage and the Burns Museum. A 10-minute walk from The Loaning takes you to Cambusdoon Sports Club.

One changing ale usually from Ayr Brewing Company.

From Maybole or Kirkoswald, it is feasible to get the bus down to Stranraer (train also available from Maybole) and visit some pubs there, or you could head back into Ayr and complete some of the walking trails listed in **Trail 4.**
